

Student Data Privacy Policy

Data Collection and Use

Purpose:

Types of Data:

Usage:

Data is utilized exclusively for program development and improvement. We do not use student data for marketing or any non-educational purposes.

SOPIPA & CCPA Compliance

- Under **CCPA**, parents and students have the right to understand how personal information is collected, used, and protected.

Data Sharing and Disclosure

Third Parties:

We do not share student data with third parties unless explicitly authorized by the educational institution and in compliance with applicable laws, including **California Education Code § 49073.1**, which mandates strict privacy protections in vendor contracts.

Parental Access & Correction Rights (UPDATED SECTION)

Parents and guardians have the right to access their child's data upon request, in accordance with **FERPA guidelines**.

 They also have the right to request corrections if student data is inaccurate or outdated, ensuring records remain precise and reflective of current progress.

Data Security

Protection Measures:

Breach Notification:

In the event of a data breach, we will promptly notify the affected educational institutions and take immediate steps to mitigate any potential harm.
